## To All London Apostolic Churches

### Prayer Theme: Unity of the Church-The Body of Christ

In John 17, Jesus' fourth prayer petition, *'May they be one'* seems to be His most passionate request. It is this part of the prayer that seems to identify the believer most, with both Father and Son.

1 CORINTHIANS 12:13

*"FOR WE WERE ALL BAPTIZED BY ONE SPIRIT SO AS TO FORM ONE BODY, WHETHER JEWS OR GENTILES, SLAVE OR FREE AND WE WERE ALL GIVEN THE ONE SPIRIT TO DRINK".*

**Psalm 133**

*1"Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity".*

[the key words here are good, pleasant, together and unity] and the scripture gives an example of how amazing it is, when we are united.

### 1. PRAYER

- Let us stand against the plans of the enemy in bringing division in our fellowship.
- Forgive us, as our divisions has brought us shame and has hindered the advancement of the gospel.
- You are not divided. Forgive us for our actions and attitudes that have appeared to divide the Body of Christ.
- Father, make us one, in the same way that You and Your Son are one.
- Help us to practice unity and give us a passion for the unity of all believers.
- May we know how good and pleasant it is when we dwell in unity.



**When we dwell together in unity:**

*<sup>2</sup>“It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, the beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments”.*

## **2. PRAYER**

- As priests unto God, may we, the Church, experience the anointing of the Holy Spirit.
- Refresh and revive Your Church again
- We need a supernatural work of Your Holy Spirit to break down our divisions and to bring us together into Your presence.

**Exodus 30:23-25** tells us that the oil used to anoint Aaron was holy. Oil is a symbol of the Holy Spirit. It was a mixture of four spices, myrrh, cinnamon, cane, and cassia, mixed together in olive oil to make a beautiful fragrance – A picture of the church - people from different backgrounds, ages and cultures coming together in unity and offering up their praises to the lord.

**2 Corinthians 2:15** *“For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved...”*

## **3. PRAYER**

- We release our praises up to You God - He has no choice but to pour down His blessings upon you.
- Bring us together in praise and worship to You, despite our style, our ability and our anointing.
- Draw us together in unity, from different cultures, backgrounds and ages.
- Despite our differences, help us to understand that we are brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus.
- Teach us to love each other - people who are different from us in so many ways, yet who are still a part of Your Body.



*<sup>3</sup>“It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion”.*

Mount Hermon that is high above the plains and valleys of Palestine, with its spotless snows, its billowy clouds, sparkling streams and cooling winds, flows down to the hot dusty Zion hills – that’s refreshing. The scripture says when you come together like this in unity, this is how it will be for you.

*“...For there, the LORD commanded the blessing”.*

**Proverbs 10:22** *“The blessing of the LORD enriches, and He adds no sorrow to it”.*

- Command Your blessings over us, Lord.
- Let goodness and mercy follow us all the days of our lives.
- May we grow in number, strength and prosper as a fellowship in all we do for Your kingdom.
- May we experience Your joy and for those of us who already have Your joy, may it be renewed.
